3. In case rates for any services required are not listed in this Tariff Book, customers must send a request to Commercial and Customer Service Department of OICT for quotation in advance.
4. No reduction in the specified charges will be applied if part of an operation or service is omitted.
5. In case of dispute, OICT reserves the right of final decision on the interpretation of this Tariff Book.
6. OICT reserves the right to alter, change or amend from time to time any, and all charges, their terms and conditions without prior notice.
